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Tournament Rules

Current IJF rules with the following safety modifications will govern:

- No double knee drop throws will be allowed for age Divisions 12 years and below.
- Shime waza (choking) and will not be allowed for age divisions 12 years and below.
- Kansetsu waza (arm locks) will only be allowed for Black belt groups.
- Pre-2003 medical rules will apply to all Junior Divisions.
- Current IJF medical rules will apply to all Senior Divisions.
- The Dynamic Edge Rule will be used.
- Contestants in the Black and Brown belt divisions **MUST** have Blue **AND** White Gis. For other divisions, Blue Gis are optional and may be worn only when the contestant's name is called first.

Shiai Format

- Divisions with 5 or more competitors will use a modified double elimination bracket, the champion will not have a loss.
- Divisions with 4 or less competitors will use a pool bracket.
- Changes in the above may be made at the discretion of the Tournament committee.
- No competitor may move down an age group.
- First, second and third place will be awarded to the Divisions indicated below.
